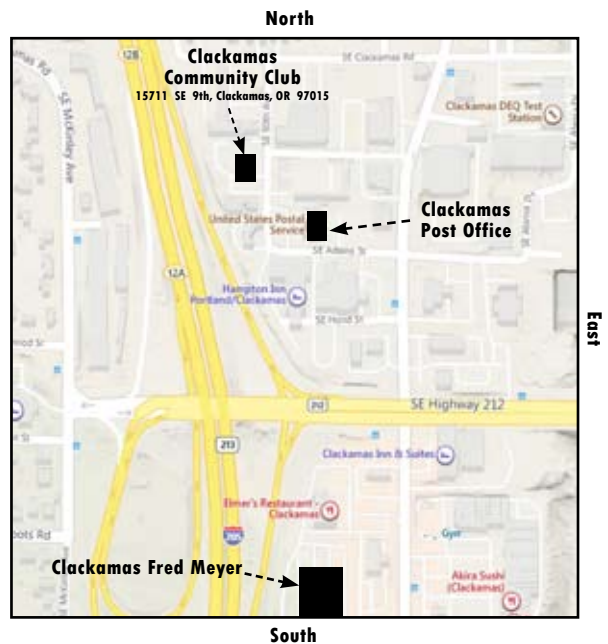

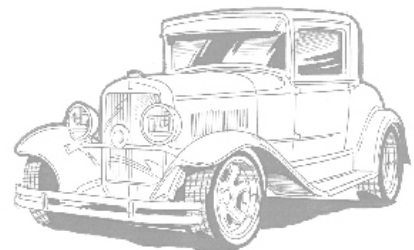
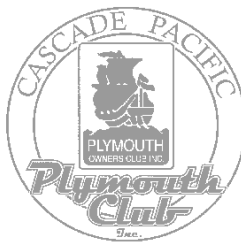

Engine number location..... All Flat 4 & 6's (1928-59) — Flat spot of left side of block directly above generator
Slant 6 — Right side of block
Early V8's — Pad between #2 & #3 cylinders
Later V8's — Right side of block below distributor; left front face of block;
right side of block next to water pump; or rail on side of block above oil pan.

Body number location..... 1928-1929 — Tag on floorboard near drivers seat
1930-1956 — Tag on engine side of firewall
1957 on — Tag on upper lip of cowl near left hood hinge
Commercials — Door post or firewall

Body Style (List coupes properly)..... 1928-1939 — either Business or Rumble Seat Coupe
1940-1952 — either Business (3 pass.) or Club Coupe (5 pass.)

2 & 4 Door Sedans 1934 — list if fitted with Form Fit Trunk
1935-1939 — list if flatback or humpback style trunk
1949-1952 — list if fastback 2-door

Wagons 1949-50 — list if all metal or wood body
